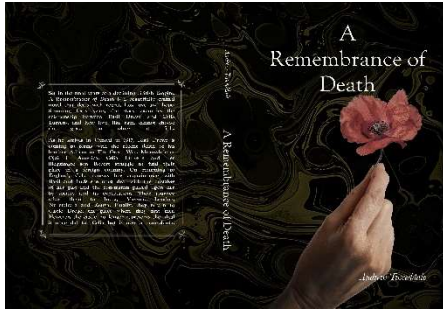

Duty. Honour. Sacrifice. What price will you pay for the truth?

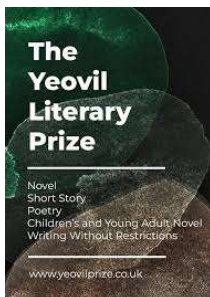

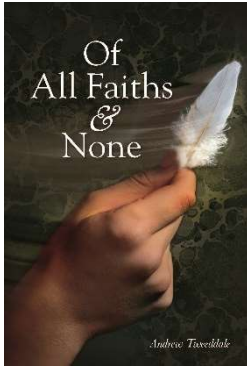
The Yeovil Literary Prize
